If you are interested in applying for the vacancy of Councillor, please apply in writing, for the attention of the Clerk, by **Friday 9th March 2018**. You will also be invited to attend the Parish Council meeting on 22nd March, where you will have an opportunity to address the Council.

Applications should include your name and address, and details such as how long you have lived in Bramley, what community activities you may be involved in, and what contribution you feel you can make to the Parish Council and any other information you feel relevant to assist the Council to help them make an appointment.

Applications should be no longer than 1 page of A4 and can be submitted either by post to Bramley Parish Council, Village Hall, Hall Road, Bramley, GU5 0AX or by email to bramleyparish@gmail.com.
