

Bramley Parish Council conference call – 2nd April 2020

1. Planning

- Members discussed the following planning applications:
 - [WA/2020/0368](#) – Additional Private Cemetery, Wintershall, Gate Street, Bramley
Change of use of land for the provision of a private cemetery
 - [WA/2020/0370](#) – Kirkstone, Barton Road, Bramley
Application under Section 73 to vary Condition 2 of WA/2018/1056 (approved plans) to allow for change to the orientation of the buildings.
 - [WA/2020/0365](#) – Tree Tops, Linersh Wood, Bramley, GU5 0EF
Certificate of Lawfulness under Section 192 for alterations to existing garage to form habitable accommodation.

2. Community support networks

- Clerk confirmed that 92 Bramley residents have volunteered to assist those who need support. 28 people have been assisted to date.

3. Bramley Update

- Mr Stern is concerned that if the referendum for the Bramley Neighbourhood Plan is delayed until this time, developers could use the delay to circumvent the plan.

- Members agreed to defer any decision on co-option of a new Parish Councillor until formal meetings can resume.
